7 Characteristics of Unstoppable people

1. Unstoppable people are ordinary people

a. Acts 4.13

Unstoppable people are not people with superhuman strength... They are ordinary people, just like we are. They are just willing to go after unordinary things.

In other words, they don't hold on to life too tightly.

2. Unstoppable people have attitude (nothing can stop me).

a. 1 Samuel 17.36

b. Caleb and Joshua had a different spirit...

They don't wait for something to happen; they make it happen.

They don't wait for the trail, they blaze the trail.

Look around us today, there are some people who are not here because it is raining. These are stoppable people. Rain today, pain tomorrow. It is the mindset... if the rain can stop me...

Inconvenience is associated with any great action. Those who wish to only do that which is convenient, will always to mediocre actions.

Jesus inconvenienced himself that he might redeem us back to the father.

3. Unstoppable people are transformers - not conformers.

a. Genesis 28.10

They make the difference.

And they make up the difference (they are able to take up for that which is lacking.)

4. Unstoppable people don't dwell in failure.

a. Peter

i. Spoke out of turn

ii. Cut off the soldiers ear

iii. Denied Christ

iv. Preached and 3000 were saved

They see mistakes as opportunities to learn not as failure. Failure implies waste, that nothing has been gained. On the contrary, people can gain much from every mistake and setback along the road to success. Mistakes and failures are inevitable and even essential; they are evidence of action. The more mistakes you make, the greater your chance of succeeding. Failures indicate a willingness to experiment and take risks. Unstoppable people know that each failure brings them a step closer to achieving their dreams.

"Many people dream of success. To me, success can be achieved only through repeated failure and introspection. In fact, success represents the 1 percent of your work that results from 99 percent that is called failure." - Soichiro Honda

5. Unstoppable people are diligent in their pursuit

Lazy people believe they are entitled to all the benefits the world has to offer yet they contribute nothing.

a. Jacob

i. 14 Years to go after Rachel

ii. Proverbs 13.4

They don't half do things... They get committed.

They get committed. They get involved. They are almost insane about it.

6. Unstoppable people don't regard their lack

a. Romans 4.

Abraham may not have had a "live womb", but he had a "living faith".

7. Unstoppable people elevate those around them

a. David's men

i. 1 Samuel 22.1-2

1. Distressed, in debt, discontented, discouraged

b. Jesus

i. Make you fishers of men.

2. Acts 4.13 - They have been with Jesus!
